CONDITIONS:

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ program as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that assures the payment of the living costs in Germany (850,00€ - 1.100,00€/ month). Each selected participant will also get a travel contribution of 820,00€. The winter term 2025/26 starts on **September 22nd**, **2025 and ends on February 20th**, **2026.** It is expected of all students to arrive at least a week before the start of the term.

APPLICATION:

If you wish to participate in the Erasmus+ exchange, first you need to apply directly at your KsTU International Affairs and Institutional Linkages Office. In case you are selected and pre-nominated by your home university, you will receive further information about the application process from HNEE. Make sure you apply with the following documents: **Deadline - 02.04.2025**

- ➤ Motivational letter for the chosen study programme
- > Current enrolment certificate
- > Transcript of records
- > A language certificate is not necessary, considering the official language in Ghana is English

An application only has a chance to be successful if all documents are submitted together and completed in full. Otherwise, your application cannot be taken into consideration.
